By submitting and publishing your work at [Arab Journal of Physical Chemistry](http://aphyschem.org), the author accepts and commits to the following terms and agreement:

- 1- Submission of work requires that the piece to be reviewed has not been previously partially or fully published elsewhere.
- 2- Upon the acceptance of the article, the author assigns to the [Arab Journal of Physical Chemistry](http://aphyschem.org) (Arab J. Phys. Chem.) the right to publish and distribute the manuscript in part or in its entirety. The Author's name will always be included with the publication of the manuscript.
- 3- The author has the following nonexclusive rights:
 - (a) To use the manuscript in the Author's teaching activities.
 - (b) To publish the manuscript, or permit its publication, as part of any book the Author may write.
 - (c) To include the manuscript in the Author's own personal or departmental (but not institutional) database or on-line site.
